

Frequently Asked Questions: (FAQs)

1. Can I perform procedures for children during my tenure as a 'Clinical Observer'?
- A** Pediatricians taking the Clinical Observership will NOT be allowed to do any medical procedures on newborns or children. Only those with clinical privileges will be granted permission to perform medical procedures on children at Lotus Children's Hospital.
2. Will I participate in Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) being done on a patient at Lotus Children's Hospital?
- A** Clinical Observers are allowed to ONLY watch CPR being performed, but cannot participate in any way in the process. This is for medicolegal reasons.
3. Can I look after children as a pediatrician during my tenure?
- A** Clinical Observers will NOT be granted permission to care for children during their Observership. This includes NO permission to write orders in patient charts, notes or any verbal or written instructions to either medical or nursing staff in any patient care area of the hospital pertaining to patient care.
4. Will I be issued a Certificate after my tenure at Lotus as a Clinical Observer?
- A** A letter stating that you have completed a "Clinical Observership Program" for the said duration would be issued. If a Certificate is needed, it would be issued instead.

- ◆ Observing meticulous nursing processes

This include DNB teaching classes and PICU Fellowship teaching classes, besides clinical teaching rounds, Guest Lectures by visiting faculty / specialists, any CME / Workshop / Seminar / Conference being conducted by LCH during the tenure in the Auditorium

Food & Beverages:

During your tenure at Lotus Children's Hospital, we provide nutritious breakfast, lunch and dinner at our Hospital Cafeteria. Two cups of coffee/tea per day will



be provided free of charge on a complimentary basis. Coupons will be provided for these for your use during your tenure here. Lunch / Dinner / Snacks will need to be paid for at the counter in the Cafeteria.

Car Parking:

If you are arriving in your private vehicle, free car parking is provided in the hospital basement.

Professional Charges for Clinical Observership:

There will be a charge for practicing pediatricians wishing to spend time at our hospital to cover for professional and intellectual knowledge being imparted, though in an informal way.

◆ One Week Observership :	₹ 10,000 / - (Rs. Ten Thousand only)
◆ Two Week Observership :	₹ 18,000 / - (Rs. Eighteen Thousand only)
◆ One Month Observership	₹ 30,000 / - (Rs. Thirty Thousand only)

Payments can be made by credit card / crossed demand draft drawn in favour of "Lotus Children's Hospital". All payments need to be made before commencement of the tenure as Clinical Observer at Lotus Children's Hospital.

Application Process:

We have made the procedure very simple! We need a letter of intent on your letterhead indicating that you are interested in the Clinical Observership Program with the duration of your choice as well as the exact dates mailed to our Human Resources Department. Once we have received your letter with the required funds and duration of observership that you are interested in, we will confirm by mail your Observership. In the meantime, we encourage you to book your accommodation in the hotel of your choice. Please report one day ahead of the start of your Observership Program and meet one of our HR Staff. There will be some paperwork to be completed and a Temporary ID badge will be issued to you, your list of privileges during your Observership, etc would be explained. The next day, please report to the HR Dept, our executives will take you to the ICUs and introduce you to the Consultants.
